Entries: Entries will be allowed on the day of the trial until 9:30 A.M. *Please notify the Trial Secretary in advance if you are considering day of show entry to speed the registration process.* Entries without fees will not be accepted. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery. All entries must be submitted on official TDAA Agility Entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopied entries without the TDAA agreement on the back or attached will not be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries will not be accepted and cannot be entered in the Trial. Credit card payments cannot be accepted. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. **Day of event entries must be given to the secretary no later than 9:30 A.M.**

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs with an NT (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons.

Measuring, Familiarization and Check In: 9:00 A.M. to 9:45 A.M., Judge's Briefing to follow.

Judging: will begin at 10:00 A.M.

- Exercise your dog responsibly! Please pick up after your dog at the show site and hotels
- All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or warm up area

Eligibility

This trial is open to all dogs measuring 20 inches or less at the withers, over the age of 12 months. The trial is not open to aggressive dogs, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance, or bitches in season. In the latter case and with a note from a veterinarian, a refund of all but \$5.00 of entry fees will be provided.

Your dog must be registered with TDAA to participate in TDAA Trials. Here is a link to the TDAA Dog Registration form: [TDAA Dog Registration Form](#). Please provide proof of submission to the trial secretary if you haven't received your number

TDAA Rules can be obtained online in the form of a PDF file at the [TDAA web site](#), and should be reviewed before competing at a TDAA trial.

Height Divisions: Per TDAA rules, dogs may be entered at any jump height desired (except at the Petit Prix: please see that premium for details); however, the scoring height continues to be the dog's measured jump height. Dogs jumping at a height other than their measured height will earn qualifying legs and all TDAA titles. The judge reserves the right to measure dogs entered in any trial. Any dog that has not previously competed at a TDAA trial must be measured before competing.

Veteran Dogs: A veteran dog is a dog of at least 7 years of age. Veteran dogs receive additional course time in standard runs and games that are timed. 4" (Measured Jump Height) veterans receive an additional 4 seconds, while 8", 12", and 16" veterans receive an additional 2 seconds.

Double Digit Veteran Dogs: A double-digit veteran dog is a dog of at least 10 years of age. Double-digit veteran dogs receive 2 seconds in addition to what a veteran dog receives for standard course time and for games that are timed.

Disabled Handler Exemption: Handlers who have been given disability status by their home state will be allowed an additional 4 seconds in standard course time for Standard courses and an additional 4 seconds in qualifying course time for Games classes. This is in addition to any additional time awarded through the Veteran Dog exemption. A copy of the handler's disabled parking permit must be sent with the entry or presented 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a handler has a permanent disability that does not necessitate the issuance of such a tag, a request for an exemption can be placed with the TDAA.

Standard Class

Beginner Agility—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Intermediate Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Beginner Agile Dog (TBAD) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Superior Agility — Only dogs who have earned the Teacup Intermediate Agile Dog (TIAD) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games Class

Games I—All dogs shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games II — Only dogs who have earned the Games I (TG1) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Games III — Only dogs who have earned the Games II (TG2) title shall be eligible for participation in this class.

Trial Games

Jumpers	Jumpers courses consist only of hurdles and tunnels, with some limitations between the different venues. The dog is required to run the course in the sequence indicated by the judge. Follow the numbers. And keep the bars up. Jumpers is usually scored Faults, Then Time (ER12) the winner being the dog with the fewest faults. If two dogs have the same number of Faults, Then Time (ER5) breaks the tie.
Gamblers	Gamblers is a two-part game: dog's choice point accumulation followed by a distance challenge. The objective of Gamblers is for the dog-and-handler team to accumulate as many points as possible in the allotted time and to successfully complete the distance challenge. Gamblers is scored Points, Then Time. ER2
Futbol	The dog and handler are required to run a jumpers course with soccer balls strategically placed. When the team comes upon one of the placed balls the handler has three options: kicking the over the hurdle for a 10 second reduction in score; picking up the ball and throwing it over the hurdle for a 5 second reduction in score; or ignoring the ball altogether, for a 5 second penalty. The handler is allowed to down his dog prior to attempting either a kick. After the kick the handler must direct his dog over the jump that served as the goal posts. If the ball drops the bar the dog will not be penalized for dropping it, but may not earn the bonus whether or not the ball went through the standards. Futbol is scored Time, Plus Faults, Less Bonus. (ER7) The dog with the lowest score wins. Futbol is played using the schedule of faults for the host organization.

Judges reserve the right to adapt any game played. Day of show rules supersede all others.

The judge's briefing, given prior to the start of judging, supersedes these descriptions and the written briefings of how to play any game. **More information about games** is available in the [Book of Agility Games](https://k9tdaa.com), 5th Edition, available at <https://k9tdaa.com>.

Warm-Ups: A warm-up area consisting of at least an agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors.

Obstacle Familiarization: Obstacle familiarization on TDAA equipment will be offered before the first class each day. One dog in the ring at a time.

Move-Ups: If your dog has moved up since you sent in your application, please notify the trial secretary at least 48 hours prior to the trial. Include the following information:

Move-ups will also be accepted if a dog completes a title during the running of this trial. In such case, the move-up request must be made immediately upon posting of scores for the class in which the title was earned. Move-ups will be accepted each day from event to event.

The following is a list of obstacles that may be used:

Pipe Tunnels (16" opening)	Teeter 12" x 12', 36" contacts, without slats
Weaves (20" centers)	Dog Walk 12" x 8' planks, 36" contacts, without slats
Tire (20" opening)	Table 3' x 3' sides
Jumps (30' wide) with or without wings	A-Frame 30" x 6' 8" ramp, 36" contacts, slatted

FEO (For Exhibition Only)

FEO (For Exhibition Only): TDAA offers FEO runs. They are open to any TDAA registered dog in any class. These are offered at the option of the local/host club. FEO dogs will run last in their jump heights. They may run on lead. FEO runs do not count toward TDAA titles. FEO teams will have a maximum time of 1.5 times the SCT. FEO dogs cannot repeat any obstacles, no training in the ring.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- All fees must be paid in US funds. There will be a Returned Check Fee of \$35.00 for returned checks. In the event of withdrawal from the event, checks will NOT be returned. All unused checks will be destroyed.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Aggressive behavior by any dog will not be tolerated. Any aggressive behavior will result in the Trial Committee evaluating the situation and determining whether any action is necessary, up to the removal of a competitor from the tournament.
- All participants in TDAA events, including competitors, judges, regional master judges, trial chairs, secretaries, members, vendors, handlers, owners of dogs, and anyone else involved with a TDAA event must refrain from behavior detrimental to the confidence, or the public perception, of the TDAA's events and integrity.
- Those involved in the TDAA's events must behave in ways that do not negatively reflect on dog agility and the TDAA.
- Conduct by anyone that is reckless, careless, perilous, turbulent, violent, or illegal puts others at risk, damages the reputation of others in the TDAA organization, and undercuts public respect and support for the TDAA is to be avoided.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct, including rough handling, verbal abuse of trial personnel, or misconduct of any kind, will result in an excusal from the ring, and possibly expulsion from the tournament.
- All dogs must be always on leash except when using the warmup area or in the agility ring per state leash laws.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the TDAA Rules and Regulations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

Accommodations/Hotels

Please contact the hotel to verify that they still accept dogs, ask about size and number of dogs allowed, and fees. Make your reservation early.

Notice: All hotels/motels are considered part of our trial site and are subject to TDAA Rules and Regulations. Our Trial Committee will consider disciplinary action for any complaints lodged against an Exhibitor. Do not allow your dog(s) to destroy property or disturb other guests. *Please*, pick up after your dog both at the hotel and the trial site.

Directions

From NJ: Route 206 North over the Delaware River Toll Bridge. Turn right onto Rt. 209 North. At the light in Milford, continue straight onto Rt. 6 West. Stay on Rt. 6 for 7 miles to the Shohola Business Center on the right.

From NY & Matamoras, PA: I-84 West to Exit 46 (Milford Exit - Old Exit 10). At the end of the ramp, turn RIGHT onto Route 6 West and follow for 5 miles to the Shohola Business Center on the right.

From PA & Points West of Milford: I-84 East to Exit 46 (Milford Exit - Old Exit 10). At the end of the ramp, turn LEFT onto Route 6 West and follow for 5 miles to the Shohola Business Center on the right.

From Hawley/Honesdale/Lake Wallenpaupack Area: Take Route 6 East. The Shohola Business Center will be on your LEFT 5.5 miles past (east of) the intersection of Rt. 6 and Rt. 434.

There is no camping at the Trial grounds, and motor homes are not allowed. No Saturday evening setup. Please do not arrive before 8:00 AM on the day of the Trial. Parking is convenient to the ring. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies & water for your dog. Crating space is very limited so X-pens are not permitted. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Agility Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged, I(we) agree to hold harmless the directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of this dog while in or upon the show/trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I(we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I(we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
